

In June, our Education Team began in-person CPR and First Aid Classes. We offer classes to both Healthcare Providers and community members.

Healthcare professionals also now have the option to choose a "blended" learning experience, which includes an online course and in-person skills-check.

We also hosted the River Region Chamber of Commerce and Entergy, who partnered to offer a Hurricane Preparedness Seminar to local businesses.
